We are very proud to present to you the annual report on the State of Illinois Business Enterprise Program (BEP) for Females, Persons with Disabilities and Minorities. In fiscal year 2007, over half a billion dollars in State agency and university contracts were awarded to qualified vendors. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Governor's efforts drive Business Enterprise to eclipse ambitious goals

Governor Rod Blagojevich continues to show an outstanding desire and commitment to helping small and diverse businesses grow and succeed. Under his leadership, the State continues to expand access and enhance opportunities for entrepreneurs through the Business Enterprise Program (BEP) and other innovative initiatives led by the Department of Central Management Services (CMS). This Fiscal Year 2007 report highlights the program's noteworthy accomplishments, identifies the total dollars subject as they relate to ambitious goals and looks towards a very bright future.

We are very excited and extremely proud to report that in FY 2007, BEP certified firms were awarded more than a half billion dollars (\$572,057,643) in State contracts. That number is more than 75 percent **above** the level required by statute.

The Business Enterprise Program helps State government promote the economic development of businesses certified as owned and controlled by females, persons with disabilities and minorities. The original Act in 1984 established a minimum overall participation goal of 12 percent that applies to agencies and universities under the purview of the Office of the Governor. In 1998, the BEP Council increased that goal to 19 percent. There are currently 52 agencies and 9 universities awarding contracts subject to the Act.

Program Eligibility and Definitions

The Business Enterprise Program is open to the following:

Female Business Enterprise (FBE): A business concern which is at least 51-percent owned by one or more females or, in the case of a corporation, at least 51 percent of the stock of which is owned by one or more females, and the management and daily business operations of which are controlled by one or more females who own it. The 51 percent_owners must be U.S. citizens or resident aliens.

Person with a Disability (PBE): A business concern which is at least 51-percent owned by one or more persons with a disability or, in the case of a corporation, at least 51-percent of the stock of which is owned by one or more persons with a disability, and the management and daily business operations of which are controlled by one or more persons with a disability who own it. The 51 percent-owners must be U.S. citizens or resident aliens. Also, a not-for-profit agency for persons with disabilities that is exempt from taxation under Section 501 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

Minority Business Enterprise (MBE): A business concern which is at least 51-percent owned by one or more minority persons or, in the case of a corporation, at least 51 percent of the stock of which is owned by one or more minority persons, and the management and daily business operations of which are controlled by one or more minority individuals who own it. The 51 percent owners must be U.S. citizens or resident aliens. Minority is defined as:

Black/African American: A person having origins in any of the black racial groups in Africa.

Hispanic: A person of Spanish or Portuguese culture with origins in Mexico, South America, Central America, The Caribbean Islands, Spain, or Portugal - regardless of race.

Asian American: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, the Indian Subcontinent, or the Pacific.

Native American or Alaskan Native: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America.

Statewide Procurement Network Gives Small and Diverse Businesses a Real Chance to Compete


Under the Governor's leadership, there has been a strong and proactive effort to streamline and strengthen the State's procurement operations. CMS built a statewide network of State Purchasing Officers, provided purchasing tools, expertise and guidance, and worked to integrate the BEP directly into the State's procurement process. The effort CMS has made to be more inclusive with diverse businesses is really paying off. The Illinois Black Chamber of Commerce named CMS its 2007 Outstanding Government Agency.

Procurement Process Timeline

Below is a timeline showing the five phases of the State of Illinois' procurement process, with an estimated time (in months) for the completion of the activity in each phase.



Certification: Tough Standards, More Efficient, Increased Vendor Pool

To determine progress towards meeting the goal, we need to distinguish businesses owned and controlled by females, persons with disabilities and minorities from other vendors. We do so through the certification process. This process calls for completion of a Universal Certification Application that will provide CMS with the information necessary to verify that the firm is owned and controlled by eligible parties and that it meets any other requirements of the Act. BEP staff will review the Universal Certification Application and may inspect the business to ensure it is 51 percent owned and controlled by one or more eligible parties as required by law.

We look at the documentation of a business's formation, subsequent history, organizational structure, financial records, and administrative operations, as well as the business and other relevant background of the owners before making a decision. Deliberate misrepresentation to obtain certification as a BEP vendor can result in civil as well as criminal sanctions. Although not strictly a part of the certification process, two other forms must be completed to ensure access to the State's procurement system. The Bidder's Application Form (BAF) gives information needed to enter a firm into CMS' computerized procurement system. In addition, before submitting the BAF, a vendor must receive a contractor registration number from the Illinois Department of Human Rights.

Based on recommendations from the BEP Council, BEP now recognizes the certifications of other relevant agencies, increasing the pool of BEP vendors and making the certification process both faster and more efficient. Vendors already certified by a recognized entity need only provide BEP with a short application, a letter of certification, and financial information. By recognizing the certification of the City of Chicago, Chicago Minority Business Development Council, Cook County, Illinois Department of Transportation, Metra, Chicago Transportation Authority, Pace, and Women's Business Development Center, the review time is now slashed dramatically.

The World Wide Web Creates a World of Opportunity for More Vendors

Documents are available online via www.sell2.Illinois.gov creating a centralized location for all applicants. www.sell2.Illinois.gov was created to help potential vendors more easily participate in the State's streamlined procurement process. The site also serves as a directory of current BEP firms. Another feature lets potential vendors learn about current and upcoming procurement opportunities for them to sell their goods and services to State agencies. Potential vendors can also register their businesses and gain access to people and resources that can help them navigate the process.

Program Integration

CMS has worked to fully integrate the State's Business Enterprise Program directly into the procurement process. The CMS experts in the Bureau of Strategic Sourcing and Procurement and the Business Enterprise Program convene regularly scheduled meetings and provide guidance to the network of State Purchasing Officers to help State agencies reach their BEP goals.

Qualified and Quantified

BEP has instituted a process to ensure that all vendors fulfill the mandated qualifications every year which helps maintain the integrity of the Program. The "No Change Affidavit" process insures that vendors are up-to-date and progress is tracked more efficiently with BEP.

Eligible businesses must have average annual gross sales of \$31.4 million or less over the three the most recent fiscal years. However, businesses with gross sales over \$31.4 million can apply for a waiver to participate in the program on an individual contract basis, if the contract will provide significant employment and/or subcontracting opportunities for minorities, females, persons with disabilities and minorities.

Of note, prior to FY07, otherwise qualified businesses were only eligible for certification if their revenues were \$27 million or less. However, based upon the recommendations and support of the BEP Council, legislation was passed which not only increased the threshold to \$31.4 million, but also required revenue averaging over the three most recent fiscal years. This point is critical in that the legislation now supports sustained revenue growth for our BEP vendors.

State's FY07 BEP Spending Far Exceeds High Expectations

In Fiscal Year 2007 BEP certified firms were awarded over half a billion dollars in State agency and university contracts, well above the statutory 12% minimum.

The FY07 BEP Annual Report now includes the Illinois State Toll Highway Authority and the Illinois State Board of Education. The results also include Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) participating in State contracts. Diverse firms performing work or providing services to State agencies under subcontracting opportunities are also now included.

The results do not include diverse companies who have not applied for BEP certification, nor does it include contracts or subcontracts awarded to firms that have grown too large to fit under the \$31.4 million annual revenue threshold to qualify for BEP certification. A number of former BEP companies have continued to win State business, after the company has "graduated" from the BEP program because of the growth in its annual revenue. This is one way to quantify that the program is achieving its goal of helping small firms build capacity.

<u>Business Enterprise Program – Setting the Standard</u>

The State of Illinois Business Enterprise Program far exceeded its 19% agency participation spending goal in Fiscal Year 2007, with State agencies spending over half a billion dollars with BEP firms.

In FY08 BEP will expand its outstanding outreach efforts to bring more economic opportunities to female, persons with disabilities and minorities. With the increased involvement, BEP will bring in a larger pool of vendors for the State of Illinois and by virtue of doing so will increase competition. BEP will work to insure that every State agency and university has the ability to meet their goals for the purchasing of goods and services from BEP firms. These efforts have set the stage for what CMS believes to be continued and long-lasting growth in the Business Enterprise Program. The progress to date has been outstanding and we believe the foundation for future success is solid. This program is an unequivocal success the people of the State of Illinois can truly be proud of.

State Legislators,

We are writing to commend you for your support through legislation of the Business Enterprise Council of Illinois Central Management Services.

As appointed members of that Council we perceive that the goals and objectives of the Council have far exceeded our charge to counsel and advice to the State of Illinois Central Management Services on enhancing and supporting the contracting opportunities for minority and women business owners and persons with disabilities.

Over the past year under new leadership, the Business Enterprise Council met regularly to meet its obligations. Participation has been active in the development of a strategic plan to strengthen minority and women's business opportunities in the state of Illinois

When you passed legislation that raised the threshold of businesses participating in the program, you greatly enhanced our ability as a council to expand the base of participation.

You recognized the need in the state of Illinois to build sustainable businesses and provided us with the opportunity to create and implement initiatives that will build the capacity of our minority and women owned businesses and persons with disabilities.

After many years of stagnant participation of M/WBEs and small businesses, and little or no information from state departments and agencies on the participation of small Illinois businesses, we will now have updated reporting to meet the state's mandated goals.

We thank you for your encouragement and support of the fastest growing segment of the economy—minority and women owned businesses and persons with disabilities.
