Re:	FY2023 Compliance Plan that Outlines Goals of Agencies, Public Institutions of Higher Education and Community Colleges for contracting with businesses

owned by minorities, women, and persons with disabilities

As of January 1, 2022, the Illinois Commission on Equity and Inclusion (CEI) instituted jurisdiction over the Business Enterprise Program for Minorities, Women, and Persons with Disabilities. The BEP Program and Council was transferred to CEI and removed from the Illinois Department of Central Management Services. Throughout the year CEI has been assessing BEP practices, protocols and guidance previously issued to agencies. CEI endeavors to enhance the state's commitment to equity and inclusion through modifying outdated, ineffective practices.

CEI will be inviting our internal clients to a kick-off in early January 2024 to discuss advancing the public policy of the State under the BEP Act by promoting and encouraging each State agency and public institution of higher education to use businesses owned by minorities, women, and persons with disabilities to the greatest extent feasible within the bounds of financial and fiduciary prudence. The Commission on Equity and Inclusion looks forward to taking affirmative steps to remove any barriers to the full participation of such firms in the procurement and contracting opportunities afforded.

We are excited to start our first collection of Compliance Plans that outline goals of agencies, public institutions of higher education and community colleges for contracting with businesses owned by minorities, women, and persons with disabilities. Below you will find instructions on how to report your plans on compliance with the BEP Act during FY2023.

**Completed Fiscal Year 2023 Compliance Plans are due to BEP on January 31, 2023.** Submit Parts I & III by completing the Microsoft Form. Submit Part II by emailing the workbook to <u>CEI.BEP.Compliance@Illinois.gov</u>.

Reporting process is comprised of three templates. these are:

I. <u>Part I: Commitment to Comply with BEP Act</u> - State Agencies, Public Institutions of Higher Education, and Community Colleges are required to affirmatively state their commitment to comply with the BEP Act. - II. <u>Part II: Compliance Plan Detail Workbook</u> Is the template through which institutions identify their total budget and exemptions at a detailed expenditure level. Return this completed template by email to <u>CEI.BEP.Compliance@Illinois.gov</u>.
