- a. Company owner, Whitney Ackermann was present. Approval was denied due to funds being provided by the company owner to Ms. Karen to buy into the company. He suggested that Ms. Karen borrows the left-over amount from a bank and provides proof of payment. Seconded by Member Johnson. Motion passed by vote.
